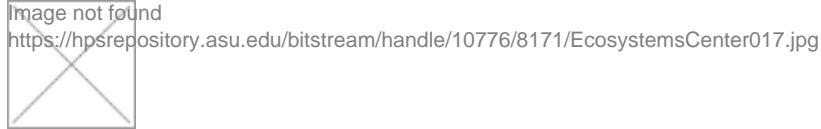


Map of Ecosystems Center researchers' forest watershed fertilizer study in Maine ^[1]
